Further Crafers Primary School acts to grace the stage will be the Drumming Group thumping out some awesome beats and the String Orchestra taking us to another world with their sublime sounds.

A performance especially for the little ones in the crowd, Kezzarumba (Kerryn Ness) is an Adelaide Hills based children's entertainer who will be performing some original & more familiar kids & family friendly songs so that everyone can join in. Kezzarumba's repertoire extends to birthday parties etc. & also includes a craft & song writing component.

Entertainment will also be provided by children from as young as four years, dancing to their heart's content with the Hills Ballet School treating us to the themed performance, "At the Beach".

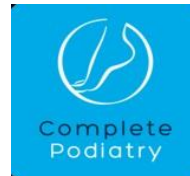
